Rules, Procedures, and Information

1. All Band and Individual Piping entries must be postmarked or received by (see below). Field entries will be accepted for Drumming events and maybe charged an additional fee. Advance entries include admission tickets.
2. **Mail entries, a stamped self-addressed legal-size envelope and checks made out to either “CSSM”, “VSGA”,**

4. You may send all entries (make copies) at one time, however, you must include an SAS envelope (and check) per games, as tickets will not all be available at the same time.
5. Tickets will be mailed to competitors prior to the competition.
6. All competitors, except for PC, must wear suitable Highland attire.
7. Band representatives meeting will be held at 10:00 am.
8. A travel allowance for bands will be paid based on mileage. To receive the travel allowance, bands must compete and participate in all massed bands. IRS form W-9 must be completed and submitted with entry.
9. Medals will be awarded in individual piping and drumming events. Cash prizes will be awarded in all Professional events.
10. Bands will receive trophies for 1st place plus cash prizes for 1st through 3rd place.
11. EUSPBA rules will apply. Decisions by judges, stewards and the Piping and Drumming Committee are final. The Scottish Games reserves the right to cancel any event for which insufficient entries are received.
12. Each “Games” will have directions posted on their websites and will be included in acknowledgement letters. Checks must be made payable to the **individual games**. Competitions are all held on Saturday.
